This May, voters will determine if La Pine Rural Fire Protection District will be able to hire more Firefighter/Paramedics to keep up with the demand of protecting and serving the La Pine Community.

La Pine Rural Fire Protection District provides fire suppression, emergency medical care, technical rescue, water rescue, hazardous material response, and fire prevention services to the La Pine Community.



WHAT HAPPENS IF VOTERS PASS MEASURE 9-157?

- **Hire 9 additional Firefighters and Emergency Medical Staff**
- **Provides for 3 crews on duty 24 hours/7 days a week**

WILL PROPERTY TAX RATES INCREASE IF VOTERS PASS THIS MEASURE?

The total tax rate for La Pine Rural Fire Protection District would be **\$3.04 per \$1000** assessed valuation, which includes:

WHAT HAPPENS IF MEASURE 9-157 DOES NOT PASS?

If Measure 9-157 does not pass, we will continue to answer emergency calls for service, but the District will be unable to keep up with the call demand resulting in extended wait times for service, potential drop in staffing, and decreased response effectiveness to medical, motor vehicle, wildfire, and structural fires.
