SERVICE ANIMAL POLICY

Service animals are allowed to accompany people with disabilities in our restaurant and any areas open to the general public.

Upon entering our business, you may be asked:

- Is the animal required because of a disability; and/or
- What work or task has the animal been trained to perform

All animals must be under control and housebroken. Dogs or therapy animals whose function is to provide comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals according to the ADA and are not allowed in the restaurant.



PERSONAL PET POLICY

Pets, including emotional support animals, are only allowed in outdoor areas and are not allowed inside the restaurant.

The only animals allowed inside restaurants are service animals accompanying persons with disabilities or police dogs.

Animals whose function is to provide emotional support, comfort, or companionship do not qualify as service animals according to the ADA and are not allowed on premise.
