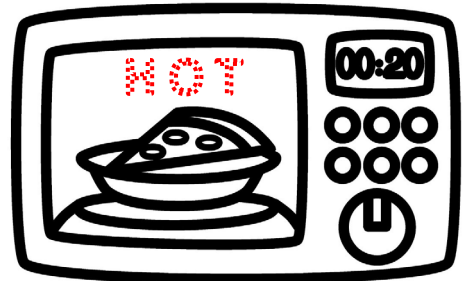

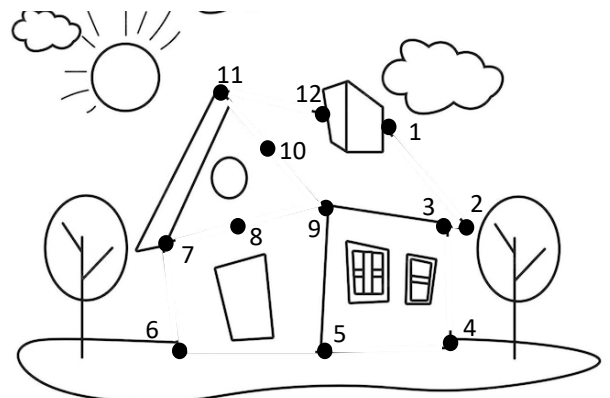
TUESDAY- E-BIKE SAFETY
